**ORDER**

The complainant Sh. Raj Kumar Sharma r/o Gali No-1, Hakikat Nagar, Janta Colony, Kath Mandi Rohtak has got an electric connection bearing A/c No. DL-1076 under Op Sub/Division No-2, Rohtak and the Forum have the jurisdiction to try this suit.

It has been pleaded by the complainant that the HT wire is barely few inches away from first floor wall which is under construction. These wires may cause electrocution / death of the persons working there. The poles on which these wires exist are not erected symmetrically which may also be got put properly.

The application of the petitioner was received in this office of the Forum on 4.03.10. Forum considered the facts and found the petition feasible of acceptance and the same was admitted. Accordingly, notice of motion dated 18.03.10 was issued to both the parties asking complainant to submit affidavit and asking respondent to submit version along with affidavit. Further notice of motion dated 4.05.10, 2.06.10, 7.07.10, 4.08.10, 9.09.10, 5.10.10 and 8.11.10 were issued.

The respondent submitted the version dated 25.11.10 stating that the complaint had been attended by his office and line shifted to a safe distance from the consumer premises as per Nigam instructions.

Forum considered the facts and observed that the grievance of the complainant has been addressed. Since the complainant did not attend the proceedings on any of the occasions, the Forum decides to dispose off the petition without any cost on either side.
