ORDER

The complainant Sh. Randhir Singh and others, R/o Village Raja Kheri, Tehsil & Distt. Panipat under SDO, Op Sub-Division, UHBVN, Chhajpur and Forum has the jurisdiction to hear this complaint.

The complainant through Advocate & Sh. Vikram Singh and Sh. Rajbir Singh has pleaded that respondent are installing the electric pole in the field of the applicant without adopting due procedure and violating the rules and regulation of electricity Act. The complainant wants that respondent be restrained not to install electric poles in their land against the rules and regulation of electricity department.

The complaint was received in the office of the Forum on 2.4.13. The Forum considered the facts and found the petition feasible for acceptance and the same was admitted. Accordingly, notice of motion dated 16.4.13 was issued to both the parties asking the complainant to submit an affidavit which is mandatory as per HERC guidelines and to the respondent to submit his version/reply duly supported with attested affidavit. Since the respondent did not submit version in time so matter taken up for hearing fixed on 24.5.2013 at Guest House, Rohtak. The complainant neither submit their affidavit nor attended the hearing on 24.5.2013. The respondent submitted the version on 24.5.2013.

The respondent submitted as per his version that the complainant has already filed CWP No. 4654 of 2012 in Punjab & Haryana High Court against the respondent which has already been dismissed on 15.10.2012. The respondent has already installed the electric poles as well as electric connection to Sh. Raj Kumar S/o Sh. Jai Kumar Malik, R/o Village Raja Kheri after getting the police protection and there is no residential house or kotha constructed at the place below the electric line & that the respondents have installed the electric poles & also issued the electricity connection to Sh. Raj Kumar as per rules of the Nigam after dismissal of CWP No. 4564 of 2012.

It is stated by the respondent in its version complainant has not come to the Forum with clean hand and has suppressed the true and material facts.

The Forum considered the facts and present complaint is hereby dismissed without any cost on either side. File be consigned to the office record.

The order is issued and signed by the Consumer Grievances Redressal Forum on 30.5.2013.
